Sailability Gold Coast is a voluntary, not-for-profit organisation providing a safe and friendly environment for people with a disability to participate in the sport of sailing or other 'on-water' activities.

Each week approximately 60 of our 100+ volunteers report to Southport Yacht Club (SYC) Sailing Squadron at Hollywell on the Gold Coast to welcome an average of 80 people with disability for a sail on one of our dinghies, a sail on one of our 7.4m Payne Salvo Day Sailors (Spirit & Hope) or a ride on the water on our pontoon boat (Freedom)

Many of our sailors with disability, together with many of our volunteers, train each week for competition sailing as part of our 'Pathways to Achievement' program.

'Competition ready' sailors compete throughout the year with SYC in national and international events in either the Hansa 303, Liberty or SKUD18 class categories.

One SKUD18 might compete up to 50 times a year in SYC competition inshore on the Broadwater, offshore Gold Coast events, the annual 'Sail Paradise' event offshore on the Gold Coast in January or national titles often held on the Gold Coast in winter.


